# VUHSK

VUHSK is one of the largest University hospitals in Lithuania:

- 28 centres
- 5090 employees, 1269 of them-fully qualified doctors
- ~400 PhDs
- 800 000 ambulatory consultations a year
- 2100 hospital beds, 83 000 a year patients treated.
- Accounts for 85% national transplantations (heart, cornea, simultaneous, kidney, liver, relative and non-relative donor bone-marrow), takes the lead in the Baltic and East European countries in the field of children's heart surgery and vascular, heart transplantations and mechanical heart implantation.
