

A simple model as starting point



Main goals



- What are the characteristics of older adults with multimorbidity (MM)?
- In patients with MM, what is the impact of chronic health conditions on QoL?
- What is the role of disability in the relationship between MM and QoL?
- Methods:
 - 5 databases in Spain
 - Older adults (65+ years)

Databases

| Database | n (total) | n (MM) | Data collection | Representation |
|----------------|-----------|--------|-----------------|------------------|
| CadeViMa | 862 | 705 | 2008 | Nationally |
| Aragón | 704 | 517 | 2008-2009 | Disability study |
| ELES | 707 | 443 | 2011 | Nationally |
| Basque country | 2108 | 1492 | 2009-2010 | Emergency rooms |
| ENSE | 5896 | 4995 | 2012 | Nationally |



Chronic conditions

Conditions common to all databases:

1. Osteoarticular
2. Asthma
3. Cardiac conditions
4. Diabetes
5. Hypertension (HT)
6. Cancer

7. Neuropsychiatric conditions:

- Alzheimer's disease
- Dementia
- Memory problems
- Schizophrenia
- Psychosis
- Mental health problems other than anxiety and depression

- EQ-5D, index (EuroQol Group, 1990).
- PWI: Personal Wellbeing Index (Cummins et al., 2006)
- WHO-DAS: World Health Organization Disability Assessment Schedule 2.0 (WHO, 2010)


Statistical analysis by database





- Inclusion criteria:
 - Age: 65+ years
 - Multimorbidity: 2+ chronic health conditions
- Descriptive statistics, prevalences.
- Logistic regression models for the group with “lower QoL”
- Control variables:
 - Age
 - Gender
 - Interaction: Disability status x chronic health conditions


Prevalence of multimorbidity by database




MM group: Age (years) and sex (%)




N° health conditions (MM group)




