- Proposed by the Hellenic Association of Gerontology & Geriatrics – Scientific coordinator
- Participation of multiple relevant scientific and professional bodies, patient associations and the National Inter-Municipal Network of “Healthy Cities”
- Funded by national structural funds
- Coordinated by the Ministry of Health

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Pilot In Older Persons for Prevention of Diabetes Type II

- Health promotion activities at Municipality Open Elderly Care Centres (KAPI):
 - provision of information
 - preventive tests on-site
 - risk assessment
 - management and referral of diabetics to organized centres

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Pilot In Older Persons for Prevention of Diabetes Type II

- A lot of Municipalities have been actively collaborating, providing educational sessions and on site tests
- A lot of health and social care professionals volunteered to participate, providing information and more organized activities

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Pilot In Older Persons for Prevention of Diabetes Type II

Why this program/experience was considered as a good practice?

It is a national project - although a pilot – aimed at improving services provided to older people **through cooperation of scientific organisations, professional bodies, primary health care services, local authorities under the coordination of the ministry of health.**

How does this experience help in driving the change of care for people with diabetes?

This project tried to improve cooperation among the different stakeholders and provide appropriate services in an organised manner, avoiding a lot of mistakes and duplication.

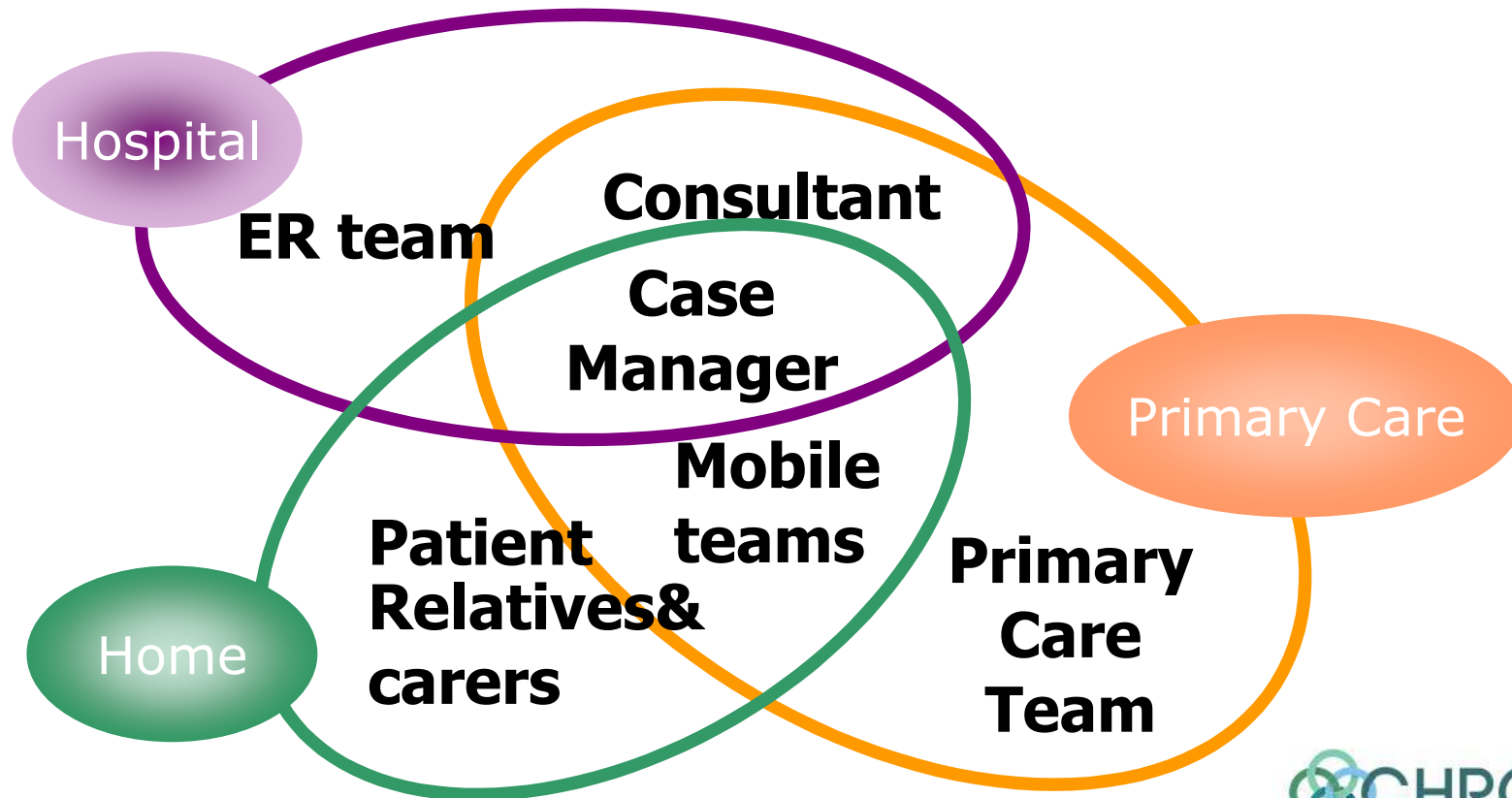

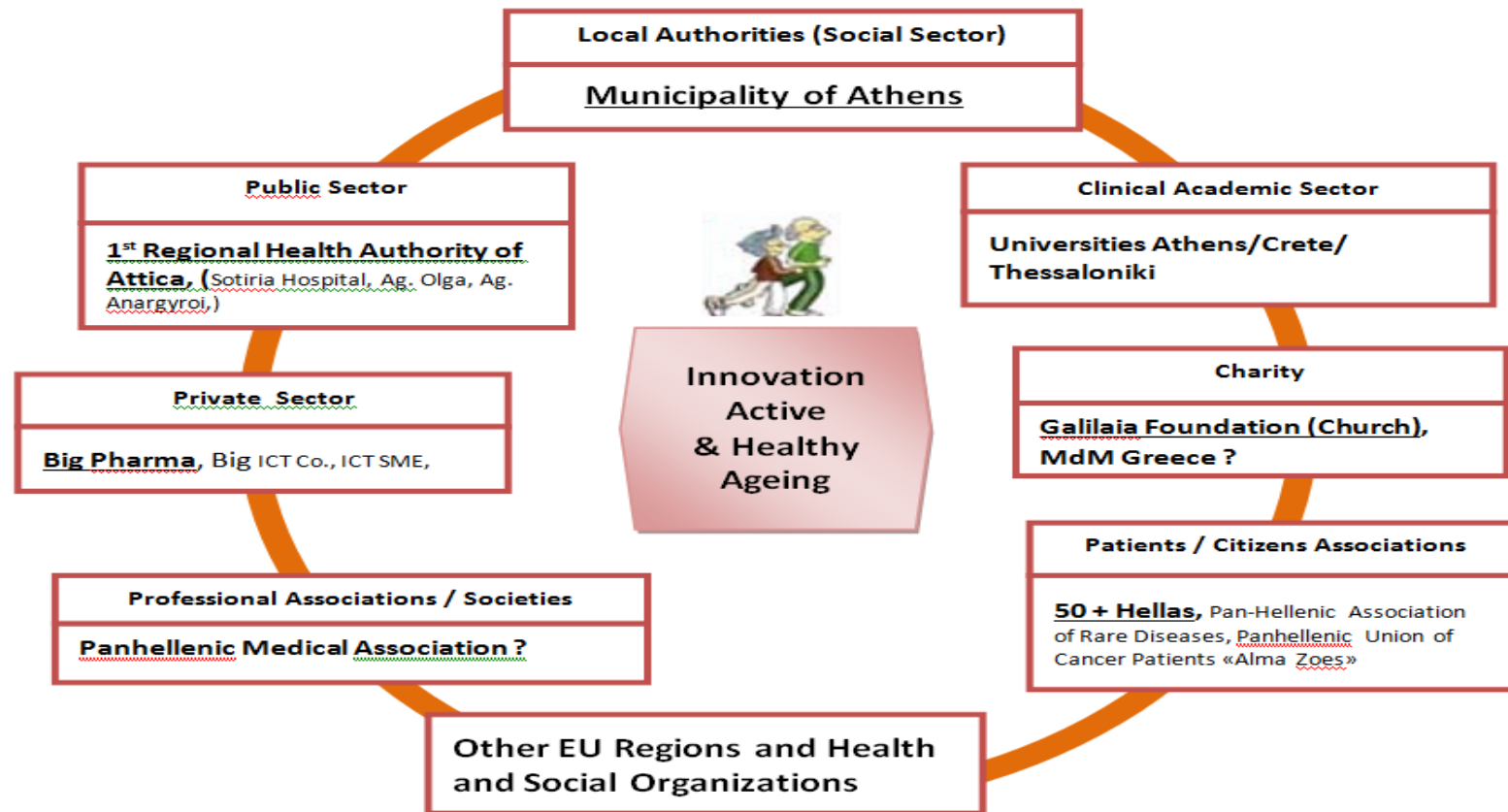
