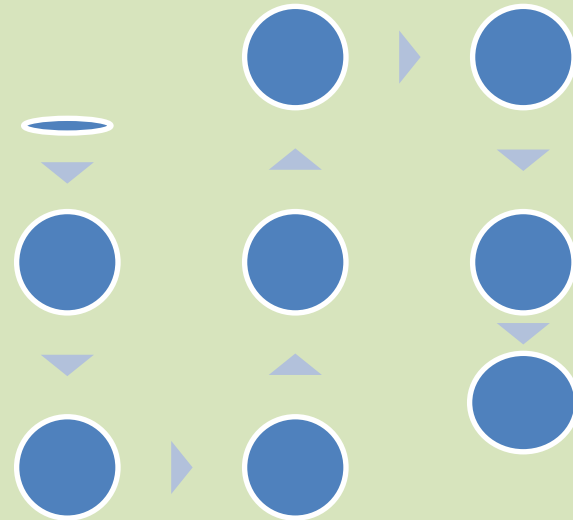
## Assumption 1:
