# The CHRODIS Platform response to the HoN principles

- 1 **Authoritative:** it is not medical advice
- 2 **Privacy:** Spanish Law 15/1999 (transposition of EU Directive)
- 3 **Attribution:** authorship is included in any content
- 4 **Justifiability:** DL as repository of references (link to the source)
- 5 **Transparency:** Contact details, platform source of funding, etc
- 6 **Source of funding:** mandatory disclosure for Users.
- 7 **Advertising policy:** forbidden to display commercial content
- 8 **Clarify of content:** structured digital content

- Implemented in the registration process
  - **Terms of use must be acknowledged and accepted to proceed with the user account creation**
- Implemented in the submission forms
  - **Conflict of interests; Copyright Policy**
