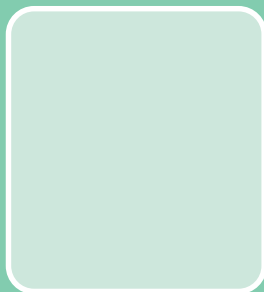

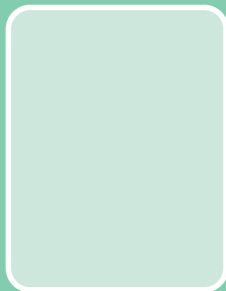

To ensure appropriate coordination and follow up of the implementation of the JA according to the plan and in communication with CHAFEA and Commission regarding the progress of the JA.

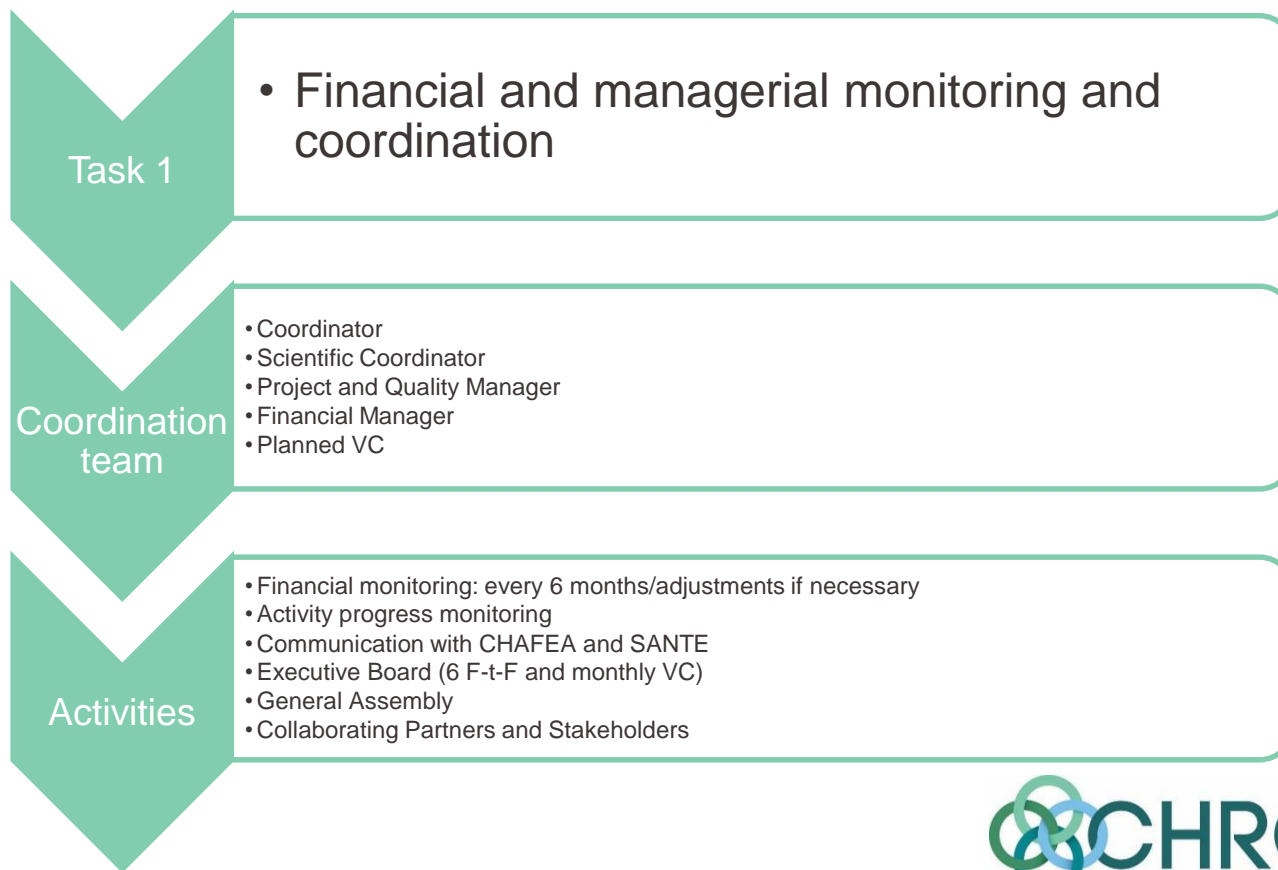
