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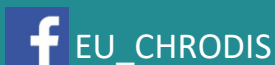

National health care plan 2016–2025:

The horizontal and vertical integration of treatment in Slovenia's health care is insufficient.

Slovenia: problem definition & solutions

Measure 1. Project for a comprehensive/integrated approach to patients in the entire treatment process

Specific objective: Integrated and comprehensive treatment

Impact indicator: Reports on the implementation of the project for comprehensive/integrated treatment

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Pilot action in Novo mesto

To develop a model for integration of care across primary and secondary level for a complex disease/state, including social care and community

C+: Fostering quality of care for people with chronic diseases using JA CHRODIS Recommendations and Set of Criteria

Target population:

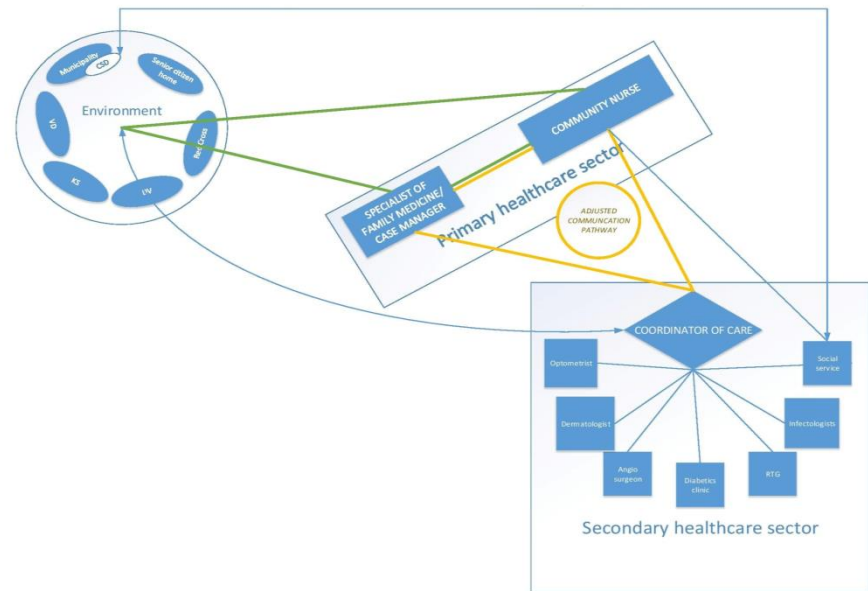
People with chronic wound
