The deliverable describes the overall implementation activity including potential for spread to other contexts, indicates implications for practice, and suggested next steps for fostering quality of care for people with chronic diseases. It reports on the key lessons learnt, including enablers and barriers, from implementation of JA CHRODIS Quality Criteria and Recommendations in at least 3 countries.
